



U - 505 In Chicago

On June 4, 1944, 150 miles west of Cape Blanco in French W. Africa, the German U - Boat, U - 505 was captured. It was then towed 2500 miles through sub-infested waters to Bermuda where its capture remained a secret until the end of the war. The task force was lead by the Carrier USS Guadal Canal and was composed of the destroyers USS Pillsbury, USS Chatelain, USS Pope, USS Flaherty, and USS Jenks. They fired depth charges, damaging the U - 505 and forcing it to surface. The rudders were damaged and the U - 505 could move only in circles. The Germans only partially opened the scuttling valves. The boarding party braved booby traps to enter the sinking sub to stop the leaks. The U - 505 was captured. Fifty-eight of its fifty-nine crew had survived. Two unexpected finds probably shortened WWII by several months. They captured a new type of acoustically guided torpedo and the German U - boat code used to direct U - Boat operations (2 Enigma machines). This ended the U - 505's patrols during which it had sunk 7 ships and was an important event that assisted the allies during the invasion of Normandy. One of only 5 U - boats left in the world, the U - 505 now rests at the Chicago Museum of Science and Industry. At 252 feet long, 750 tons and 37ft high, this type 9c U - Boat is immense. There are on board tours, which give you a glimpse of U - Boat duty. Tours at sea lasted 90 days. Quarters were tight and no showers. The crew never saw the sunlight during this period. They used a rotating bunk system for sleeping. The sub ran on diesel engines on the surface and batteries underwater. Surface speeds reached 18.9 knots and 7 knots submerged. The U - 352 off Morehead City, North Carolina is a fantastic dive. At 115 feet, it is easily accessible within recreational limits.
