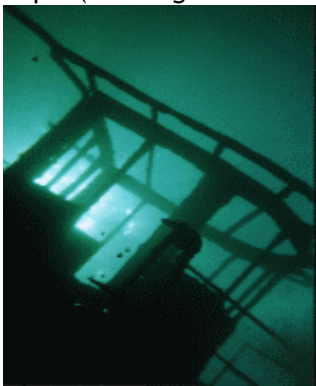


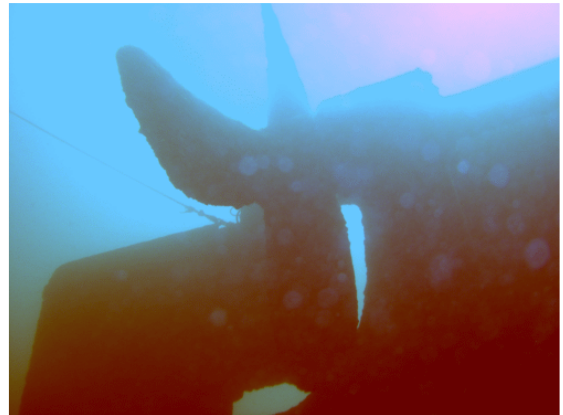
“Warm Water Diving in the Canadian Caribbean...

Yes, the words “warm” and “Canadian” are together in the same sentence! For those that have yet to discover the breath taking Thousand Island Region of Ontario and Upper New York State you may have a hard time believing that this could be true of the “Cold North”. The St. Lawrence River hit 80 degrees Fahrenheit in the summer of 2005 with a normal average being in the mid 70’s. A big feature of diving in the St Lawrence is the absence of thermo clines - warm even at depth! But the warmer water is just one of many reasons the St. Lawrence River is being heralded as possibly the best fresh water diving in the world. Not so many years ago, the visibility of the St Lawrence was only 3’ - 10’ due to silt and organic particulate. Now, since the inadvertent introduction of the zebra mussel from the bilge of passing ships, visibility has dramatically increased to up to 80’ on a good day, but still 25’ - 30’ even on a bad day. Having always been a major trade route, the Thousand Islands Region has seen a lions share of marine mishaps resulting in sunken ships from small wooden barges to 400’ steel freighters creating dive sites suitable for beginners through to technical divers. Bad weather played a major part in many accidents, fog, wind and storms mixed with treacherous shoals made for a tough passage through the narrow shipping channel. Ships like the Keystorm, a 256’ steel steamer with 2 boilers and a triple expansion, 3 cylinder engine was carrying 2230 tons of Bituminous coal bound for Ashtabula, Ohio, when 45 min. past Alexandria Bay in heavy fog on Oct. 12, 1912 she crossed over Outer Scow Island Shoal. The pumps were put into operation immediately, but 5 hours later she sank stern first rolling over. The Keystorm lies on her starboard side; her bow is at 20’ depth and her stern is at 115’. She was deemed unsalvageable with double wrappings of 4” cable at 20’ intervals remaining from salvage attempts (her cargo was salvaged).



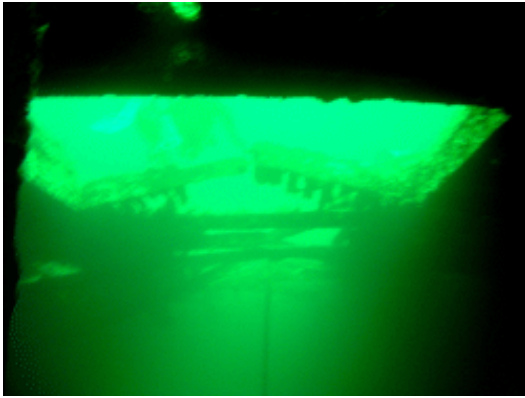

The Daryaw, a 219’ steel freighter succumbed to the same fate when she too drifted out of the shipping channel in dense fog finishing upside down in 90’ of water. Bad storms claimed a number of vessels including the Lillie Parsons a double masted (fore & aft) retractable centerboard schooner built in Tonawanda N.Y. in 1868. She was being used to transport 500 tons of coal when a squall shifted her cargo, pushing her into Sparrow Island in the Brockville Narrows. She started taking on water, capsized, and sank. She lies upside down, against the island (in a quick current) with the bow downstream in about 70’ on a rock bottom. The Stern and its impressive rudder lies upstream at about 20’ depth. This awesome dive site is very unique as you enter at one end of the island following a huge anchor chain attached to an anchor on shore to get to the wreck and at the end of the dive, you allow yourself to drift with the current along the side of the island and around into the picturesque bay where your dive boat awaits. The Kingshorn, a 130’ wooden barge was also caught in a bad storm and sunk along with 3 other barges just off the port of Rockport. She sits upright in 90’ of water with a medium current. This wreck is a photographers delight with some awesome ships parts including an in tact ships wheel, bilge pumps and a pot bellied stove to name but a few.

The local Upper St Lawrence Scuba Charter Association works together with Save Ontario Shipwrecks to preserve and protect the wrecks by promoting low impact diving, enforcing a "take only memories and leave only bubbles" mentality and promoting safe diving practices. The two associations work hand in hand to maintain two moorings on each of the wrecks to minimize the risk of damage from anchors and providing a safe and secure mooring for all divers. The Gaskin has an interesting story line and holds the record for sinking the most number of times in the area! Launched as a triple masted iron rigged schooner and later converted to a work barge, the Sir Robert Gaskin was in the process of salvaging the Armstrong when one of the pontoons broke free and torpedoed to the surface, smashing through the Gaskin's starboard bow causing her to sink on top of the Armstrong. The first attempt to raise her failed when one of the couplings broke free and she sank a second time. The second attempt to raise her was successful, however, her stern pulled away as she headed into shore and she sank for a third and final time. Perfect for newer divers, the Gaskin sits in 60' of water with a very mild current right in front of downtown Brockville who has benefited greatly from the increased number of divers now that the town has become a dive destination with 20 members of the local charter association operating out of St Lawrence Park on the edge of town. The Dive Brockville Adventure Centre located at the downtown waterfront provides a full service dive facility with a good supply of diver accessories and souvenirs. Nitrox and Trimix is available, as well as Oxygen and scrubber material for rebreather divers. Operating out of the Adventure Centre is Abucs scuba Charters, with 10 years of chartering experience, 3 dive boats and 1000's of happy divers. They are available for individual or group charters every day of the week with the season running from May 1st through to the middle of November and all-inclusive packages are available with accommodation at the local Comfort Inn. Along with the exciting, intact wrecks you can also Explore underwater canyons and walls while drifting effortlessly along. An added bonus is finding a treasure - a bottle or clay pipe which still litter the bottom are uncovered on a regular basis as the silt shifts with current.

If you want an exhilarating dive expedition and you haven't had the pleasure of diving in fresh, warm water with great visibility and world class dive sites then don't delay, plan your trip today."
