Turks and Caicos Travel Review

Often winter in Columbus seems to have no end. Well, there is no better excuse to avoid Seasonal Affect Disorder than taking a trip to the warmth and sunshine of the Caribbean. And what better place than Turks and Caicos to provide a wonderful above and below the water experience for scuba diving aficionados. Located just 575 miles from Miami, Turks and Caicos consists of over 40 islands of which only 8 are inhabited. It is an easy trip from Columbus through Charlotte on US Air that will get you there by 2pm, plenty of time to enjoy your complimentary arrival drink and get all your diver gear ready to make a splash. I recently took an eight day holiday splitting my time between Providenciales and Grand Turk to see what each island had to offer.

My first stop was the island of Providenciales or known as 'Provo' for short. It is the main center for the travel industry with all-inclusive resorts and multi-million dollar beach front condominiums being built as quickly as possible. And while the construction seems to be growing boundlessly it is the twelve miles of one of the Caribbean's most beautiful beaches and the pristine reefs that make this a world class vacation destination. Numerous dive operators are available to help you explore the scores of sites around the island. Some people might be wary of the forty to sixty minute boat ride but with large comfortable boats and humpback whales occasionally breaching during the trip out I found them relaxing and enjoyable. At most dives sites you will discover colorful walls that start at forty feet and continue to hundreds of feet below. The reefs are a photographers dream, each site full of brilliant colors, amazing hard and soft corals, and the possibility of sharks, manta rays, turtles and huge groupers. Back on shore surface intervals can be passed with walks on the soft beaches, superb bone fishing, a championship golf course and numerous bars and fine restaurants.

A quick 20 minute flight across some of the bluest water imaginable lands you in the islands governmental capital of Grand Turk. Reported to currently have only 95 hotel rooms on the island, Grand Turk is a sleepy place where diving and sunning are the main activities. Apart from the newly open massive cruise ship docks that can double the number of people on the island during the day you quickly feel like a local. With exceptional dive sites only 5 minutes away nothing can upset your days on Grand Turk except perhaps missing the elusive green flash that can occur during sunset.
